## Edkasa discussed to promote digital learning in FAS Schools

On Friday, January 5, 2024, Abdul Jabbar Mari, Director of Program & Planning and HR, chaired a meeting at the SEF Head Office with Edkasa CEO Mr. Fahad Tanvir, Deputy Director Programs (North, Central, and North), and

Mr. Fahad Tanvir presented a proposal on blended learning and discussed the piloting of the intervention in Foundation Assisted Schools. The primary goal of this initiative is to enhance English, Mathematics, and Science learning in early grades. It was noted that Edkasa is already in partnership with SEF and has granted scholarships to students from grades IX to XII. The SEF team commended Edkasa's efforts in promoting digital learning for students.

The meeting discussed current CCTE program enrolment for students and ways to increase it. It was suggested that SEF, PIMSAT, and TANG support students in CCTE programs, providing more job options for SEF students and alumni. As a part of this initiative, SEF students who completed Matriculation and are in Intermediate can join a 2-year CCTE program in Pakistan and a 1-year CCTE program in China through the TANG scholarship.


Students presented a variety of science models and participated in speech competition and tablaues. The management of Foundation Assisted SDF Education System High School awarded prizes to the best teachers and students.
